RE: Lead-Free Compliance Confirmation – Zellige Ceramic Tile

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter serves as confirmation that our Zellige Tile products comply with applicable U.S. federal regulations regarding lead content and may be represented as Lead-Free in accordance with established standards.

Testing was conducted by the International Product Assurance Laboratory (IPAL), an ISO/IEC 17025–accredited testing laboratory, using applicable ISO and ASTM testing methodologies and X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) for the determination of lead content in ceramic and glazed products. Testing procedures were performed in accordance with guidance issued by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC).

Under current CPSC regulations, consumer products may contain up to 100 parts per million (ppm) (0.01%) of total lead in accessible components. Additionally, paints and similar surface coatings are considered lead-free when lead content does not exceed 90 ppm (0.009%).

Laboratory testing of our ceramic tile, as documented in International Product Assurance Laboratory Test Report No. IPAL 0734-25, confirmed a lead content of 67 ppm, which is below both the 90 ppm surface coating threshold and the 100 ppm total lead content limit. While the term “lead-free” does not indicate the complete absence of lead, it reflects compliance with applicable regulatory limits, recognizing that trace environmental levels may be present.

Based on these test results and current regulatory guidance, our ceramic tile meets applicable lead-content requirements and may be designated as Lead-Free.
